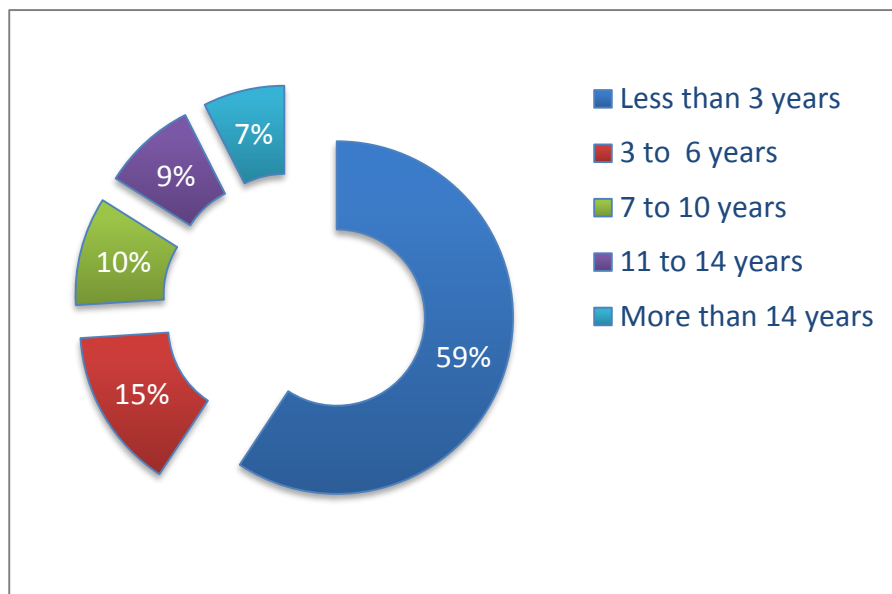

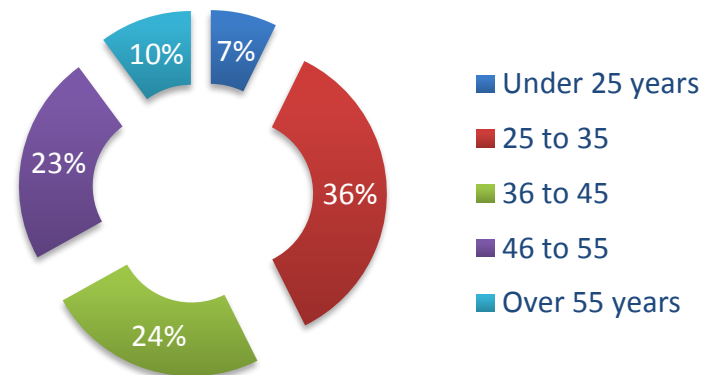
## Human Capital

On average, collaborators has less than 3 years of seniority

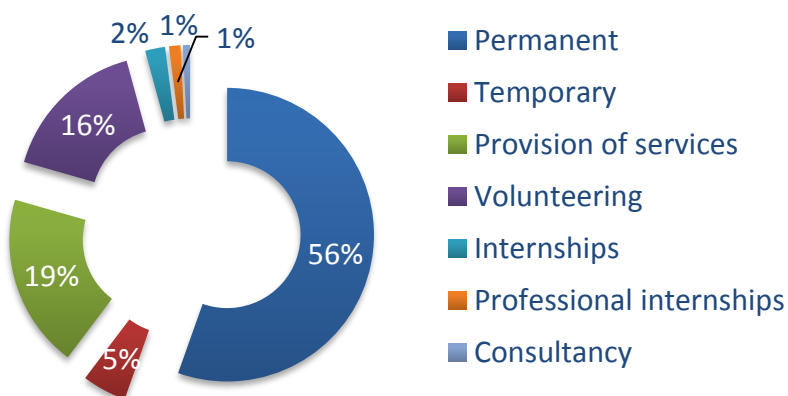
### Age



The age group most represented is 25-35 years

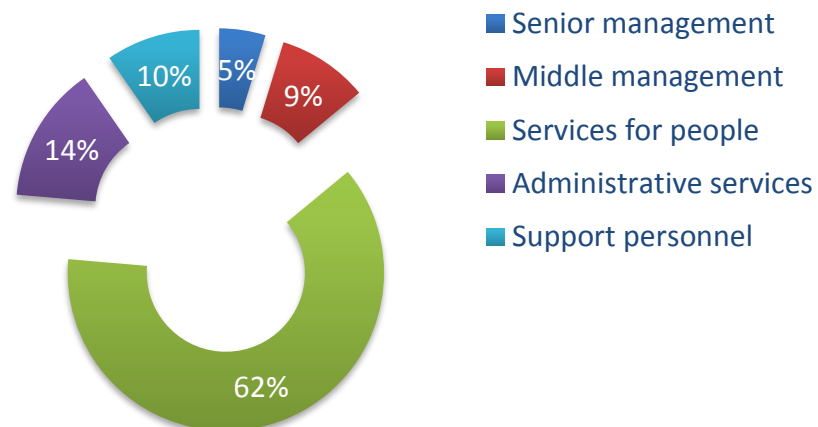
## Human Capital
