ABOUT

Science is increasingly proving that a significant portion of drug-related problems is preventable.

On June 9th, 2023, international experts met in Oviedo, Spain, to explore effective strategies for preventing drug use aligned with international scientific standards. Stemming from the consultation, and with the involvement of more than 200 experts and 100 country focal points, the Declaration of Oviedo has been adopted as a **2024 global initiative to scale up evidence-based prevention at the forefront of drug policy.**
